NDSL Digital Collections

Gordon & Emma Anderson Collection

Items relating to the Anderson and Landers families from the Kenmare and Crosby areas of North Dakota (Ward County and Divide County), from the late 1800s to the late 1900s.

North Dakota Atlases & Plat Books Collection

Historical atlases and plat books from North Dakota counties.

North Dakota Histories Collection

Historical atlases and plat books from North Dakota counties.

North Dakota Memories Collection

Images, documents, and objects that have been digitized from the collections of North Dakota residents, organizations (such as businesses, churches, etc.), and cultural heritage institutions (such as libraries, archives, museums, historical societies, etc.).

North Dakota School for the Deaf Collection

Newsletters, reports, photographs, videos, objects, and documents relating to the North Dakota School for the Deaf in Devils Lake, since its inception in the 1890s to the present.

North Dakota State Documents Collection

Publications, reports, videos, newsletters, etc., generated by North Dakota state government agencies since before statehood in 1889 to today.

Political Prairie Fire

A collection dedicated to the Nonpartisan League (NPL) and Independent Voters Association (IVA) era of North Dakota History, circa 1910-1930. The collection includes many images, documents, books, and cartoons relating to this era of political strife in North Dakota.

Prairie Recipes Collection

Cookbooks, recipes, and cooking guides from across the Northern Plains and the state of North Dakota.

T. E. McMillan Diaries Collection

Diaries from 1888 to 1947 about the life of a North Dakota homesteader and farmer.
